

DID YOU KNOW... you can listen and reply to a message directly from within the text message?

How to call the Listen or Reply number directly from within a 2me text message.

The procedure is very simple. The guidance notes below describe the general principles which may vary from manufacturer to manufacturer and phone to phone. However, with a little experimentation you will see how easy it is.

Smartphones (phones **with** a touch screen, stylus or navigation ball to select text)

The 2me message should be open on the screen and the Listen and Reply numbers visible in the window. Now, simply touch or scroll to select the number you want to call and then press SEND, CALL or **↵** to call the number.

Regular phones (phones **without** a touch screen, stylus or navigation ball)

The principal methods to call a number from within a text message are described below.

Callback method

On some phones with the 2me message open on the screen simply press the SEND, Call or **↵** to display a list of all the phone numbers embedded in the text message. In all cases; the first number in the list is the person who left you the message, the second is the Listen number, the third is the Reply number. Scroll to the number you want to call and press SEND, Call or **↵** to call the number.

Extraction method

For some phones you will have to use the soft key menu buttons to extract the numbers embedded in the 2me message.

The 2me message should be open on the screen and the Listen and Reply numbers visible in the window. At the bottom of the screen you will have 2 buttons. Press the one marked MENU or OPTIONS, then scroll to the feature named Extract Data/Use Number/Extract number (the exact name of the feature is dependent upon the phone you are using). Select this feature; your screen will now list all the phone numbers contained in the text message. In all cases; the first number in the list is the person who left you the message, the second is the Listen number, the third is the Reply number. Now scroll to the number you want to call and press SEND, Call or **↵** to call the number.

Remember: Call the **Listen** number to hear the recorded message. Call the **Reply** number to dictate a text message back to the caller. Call the **From** number to speak to the caller.
